## Our Affordable Studio Rental Program



**CHALLENGE**: How can we amplify our contribution to New York City's thriving cultural ecosystem by providing local musicians with desperately needed rehearsal spaces at affordable rates?

In a city where space is at a premium, it is increasingly difficult for musicians to find affordable, easily accessible, acoustically suitable places to rehearse and collaborate.

SOLUTION: With 19 new Steinway pianos and a renewed appetite, post-Covid, for in-person musical collaboration, we invested in developing and marketing a comprehensive, techenabled rehearsal space rental program.

We customized a software platform to allow musicians to check availability and book rentals online, secured multiple grants to subsidize rental rates, promoted our space rental program widely and hired a part-time engagement coordinator. When our 17 studios are not being used for lessons, classes or music therapy, they're now often filled with bands, ensembles and solo artists practicing their craft.

## IMPACT:

- Nearly 1,300 musicians reflecting the city's rich cultural tapestry have registered on our platform, including a concert cellist, a Bulgarian women's choir and an Afro-Cuban experimental electronic band.
- Over the last 12 months, we've rented studios for a total of 5,974 hours, including 3,000 hours that were free of charge due to third-party funding.
- Participating musicians draw from 129 zip codes, elevating BKCM's status and visibility as a hub for creativity, collaboration and musicianship.
