All music therapy sessions in Park Slope register by 15-week semester. Sessions are scheduled on an individual basis to best meet each student and family's needs. Families may register up to 10 weeks into a semester and pay prorated tuition based on the number of weeks remaining.

30-minute Dyad Sessions: \$855 (\$57 per session)

45-minute Dyad Sessions \$1,140 (\$76 per session)
